

Mentorship Program for Class of 2026 Mentor Application

Purpose

The purpose of the American Association of Legal Nurse Consultants (AALNC) Mentorship Program is to enhance the skills of novice legal nurse consultants to inspire and empower them to achieve their full potential in the legal nurse consulting career path.

Overview

The AALNC Mentorship Program is a 12-month mentorship program designed to support the novice legal nurse consultant (LNC) in their career. Qualifications

Applicants must be

- AALNC member in good standing
- Practicing LNC for 10 years or more
- Interested and invested in fostering personal professional development in others, to help them in pursuing an LNC career
- Any clinical background or practice area
- Be able to commit to monthly meetings with Mentee and attend quarterly Mentorship meetings with cohort.
