



American Association of Legal Nurse Consultants Mentorship Program for Class of 2026

Purpose

To improve the skills of novice legal nurse consultants and to inspire and empower them to reach their full potential in the legal nurse consulting career. The AALNC Mentorship Program offers a resource for novice LNCs to evince a pathway to growth.

Overview

The AALNC Mentorship Program is a 12-month initiative designed to support the career development of legal nurse consultants (LNCs). It offers a personalized match with an experienced LNC to mentor and guide participants throughout the year. Mentees will be enrolled in the Mentorship Class of 2026 and cohort networking opportunities.

Participants will also receive:

- One-on-one mentorship with their mentor match throughout the 12 months, with a minimum of a monthly check-in.
- Mentorship Program Guidebook, outlining program expectations, recommended meeting frequency with suggested topics, and additional information.
- 50% off registration pricing for AALNC's 2026 Annual Forum, taking place March 12-13, 2026 in Orlando, FL. (\$290 value)
- Complimentary access to identified AALNC tools and resources
- 20% off registration pricing for LNC Jumpstart Virtual Workshop in 2026 (approx.. \$50 value)
- Access to a dedicated Shared Interest Group
- Complimentary access to Growing Your Practice (\$200 value)

To make the most of their time in the program, accepted participants are asked to:

- Make space for connecting with mentor each month - determine best form of communication and frequency.
- Utilize workbook and materials to prepare goals and topics for meetings with mentor.
- Schedule time each month to note questions and areas for support and take actionable steps towards meeting goals.
- Actively check-in and work to create a community with other mentors and mentees in the SIG Mentorship Program Group.

AALNC Mentorship Program Class of 2026 will begin in January 2026 and run for the duration of the 2026 calendar year.

Qualifications

Applicants must be

- AALNC member in good standing
- Active, unrestricted RN license or related healthcare professional for a minimum of three years
- Practicing LNC for ten years or less
- Interested and committed to personal and professional development to pursue an LNC career
- Any clinical background or practice area

- Can you commit to setting up and attending monthly meetings with your Mentor, and attend quarterly mentorship meetings with your cohort?
- Have you participated in a mentorship program before? If so, what was the focus, and what aspects did you find helpful or challenging?
- What sparked your interest in legal nurse consulting and how has your experience in the field developed so far?
- In addition to your mentor, provided guidebook, and access to specific AALNC education and resources, is there additional support you anticipate needing as a mentee?

Tuition

This program is exclusively available to AALNC members in good standing. A \$50 non-refundable application fee is required to complete your application. An invoice for the application fee will be sent once all materials are submitted. Tuition costs \$1,999 and must be paid in full at the time of acceptance and program start in January 2026.
