The ATHENA Award actively supports and celebrates the ATHENA International and Empower Her Committee of the Henderson County Chamber of Commerce missions of supporting, developing and honoring women leaders, inspiring women to achieve their full potential – creating balance in leadership worldwide. The ATHENA Award honors individuals who strive toward the highest levels of personal and professional accomplishment, who excel in their chosen field, devote time and energy to their community in a meaningful way, and forge paths of leadership for other women to follow.

THE CRITERIA

ATHENA Recipients must meet each of the following five criteria:

- Demonstrate excellence, creativity and initiative in their business or profession
- Provide valuable service to improve the quality of life for others in their community
- Assist women in reaching their full leadership potential
- Live or work in Henderson County
- Must be at least 21 years old

COMPLETING THE FORM

- Nominations for the ATHENA Award <u>must</u> be submitted using this nomination form
- Typed applications are STRONGLY encouraged

- You may include two additional pages of supporting documents (i.e. resume, CV, etc.)
- The information submitted should support the award criteria of achievement, leadership and service.
- Must include high-resolution (300dpi) JPEG file headshot of your nominee.
- Deadline for nominations is Friday, January 16th, 2026
