New Member Orientation Mandatory Training

The Piedmont Regional Association of REALTORS® New Member Orientation is mandatory for all new members.

In accordance with the Piedmont Regional Association of REALTORS® Bylaws (Article V, Section 2, Qualifications): "As a condition of membership, the applicant agrees to complete a course of instruction covering the Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the Association, the Bylaws of the State Association, and Constitution and Bylaws of the National Association of REALTORS®."

PRAR New Member Orientation is a four-hour training session in both Association business and in the Code of Ethics.

Once member fees and application is received, notification will be given of the next orientation date if you are unable to attend that scheduled orientation, you will be placed in a probationary status and scheduled for the next orientation.

Failure to attend the second scheduled orientation will result in the new member's application being revoked and all REALTOR® privileges terminated. No monies are refunded. And there will be a reinstatement fee of \$125.00

As a member of PRAR it is mandatory for all members to receive Two and a half hours of Code of Ethics Training and Two hours of Fair Housing Training every three years. The training required has been established by the NAR Board of Directors. This Mandatory Training will be provided online for free, Online/in person for CE at a cost, and at least once per year in person (for free) providing several opportunities for you to meet the requirement.

PRAR COMMITTEES AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

- COMMUNITY SERVICE:** Designs and implements programs, which encourage membership involvement in the community. Promoting the national celebration of home ownership and private property rights.
- PROGRAMS AND MEMBERSHIP:** Plan and coordinate membership meetings. Recommend to the PRAR Board of Directors meeting menus and guest speakers. Responsible for recruiting and retention of membership.
- AFFILIATE'S LIAISON:** Provides a communication vehicle for REALTOR®, Affiliate Members. Responsible for recommendations to the PRAR Board of Directors for educational programs, ideas of common interest and services.
- Young Professional Network:** YPN helps young real estate professionals excel in their careers by giving them the tools and encouragement to become involved in four core areas:
- RPAC:** Sets goals, plans and implements programs designed to collect funds used in the support of campaigns for candidates running for state and national political office. Plans and conducts educational programs to enlighten membership as to the meaning and importance of RPAC.
- ISSUES/MOBILIZATION:** Responsible for attending local/county/school board meetings, and reporting any issues that might impact our industry. Work with Brokers to mobilize members to action an issue when requested by the Board of Directors.
- FAIR HOUSING:** Promotes education and the understanding of Fair Housing Law to the members
