- Maryland Farm Bureau Annual Convention/Next Gen Summit (December 5th&6th, 2026).

Awards:

- The two (one female & one male) selected PGCFB Ag Ambassadors will each receive a \$1,000 Scholarship.
- Represent PGCFB at Day-in-Annapolis, Banquet, Annual Meeting, and other events.

It must be completed and submitted before September 25th, 2026, at 4:00pm EST, along with your resume. You will be required to attend orientation (in person or virtual) and compete in an in-person interview and Discussion Meet panel at the 111th Annual Meeting of the Maryland Farm Bureau (Saturday, December 5 & Sunday, December 6, 2026). The MFB application and the PGCFB application are almost identical.
