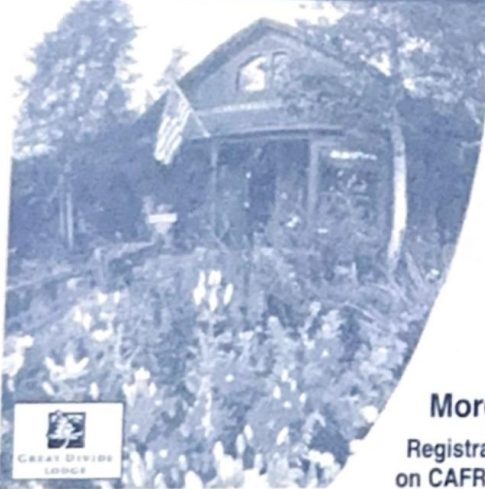





CAFR committees

CAFR is a membership based organization. It has a Board of Directors that is responsible for making decisions for the organization and directing it. All of CAFR's programs are designed and coordinated by committees made up of volunteers. These committees make programs happen, they secure additional volunteers, they secure funding and they make CAFR visible. For the organization to work we need our members to actively participate in at least one committee. If you have not already signed up for a committee please do so as soon as possible. Even if you can not regularly attend meetings you can stay informed and voice your opinions and provide expertise.

Committees

Summit Planning Committee. This committee plans and coordinates all aspects of the Colorado Summit for Recycling. Volunteers assist in planning the agenda, securing the conference location, designing the promotional brochure, securing sponsors, securing speakers and much more.

Web Site Committee. This committee maintains and plans the development of CAFR's web site. With the constant improvements in technology we are just getting started. We need editors, techies and those who are just interested.

Policy Committee. This committee tracks recycling related policy issues, discusses policy needs and acts as a source of expertise in the waste reduction and recycling field for policy and decision makers.

Rural Recycling Committee. This committee sponsors and hosts four rural recycling workshops to discuss issues and solutions to help rural recycling programs become successful.

America Recycles Day. This CAFR committee is the state coordinator for America Recycles Day events and promotions in Colorado. If you are interested in hosting an event in your community or want to plan ideas for Colorado this is your chance to become active.

Special Event Planning Committee. Frequently special events arise during the year that were not planned by CAFR. This committee acts quickly to make sure that CAFR is active and visible in unplanned events and promotions.

Membership Committee. The membership committee is responsible for member services and administration. The committee works on membership development such as benefits for members, how to attract new members and how to keep members active and interested.

Sponsorship Committee. This committee is responsible for securing private sponsorships for CAFR programs and events.

Newsletter Committee. This committee is responsible for writing, editing, securing articles, printing and distributing CAFR's quarterly newsletter.

CAFR is always open to the opportunity for additional committees. Some new committee currently in the works are College and University and the Buy Recycled Business Alliance.

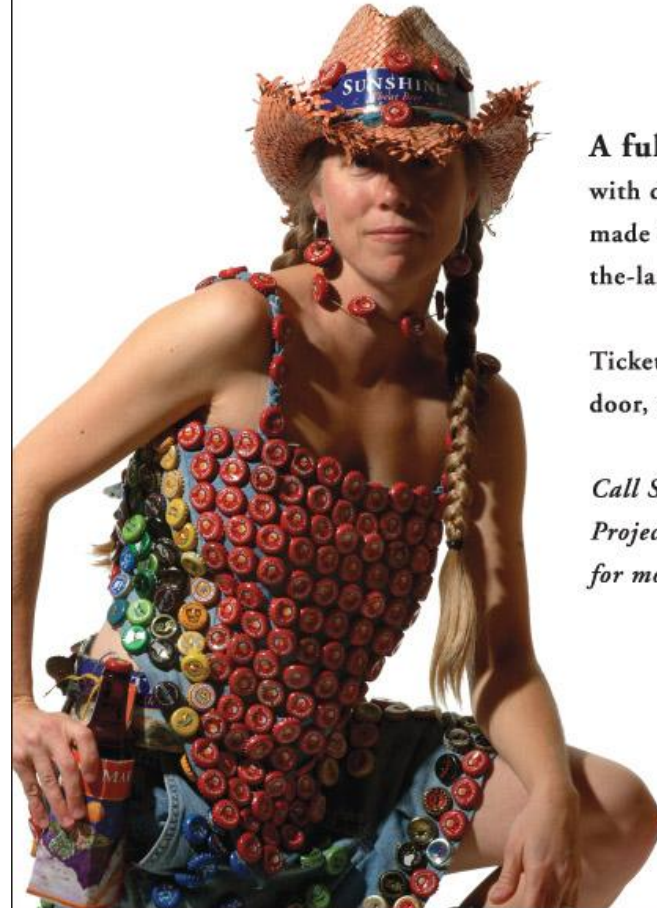
