WELCOMING NEW BOARD LEADERSHIP

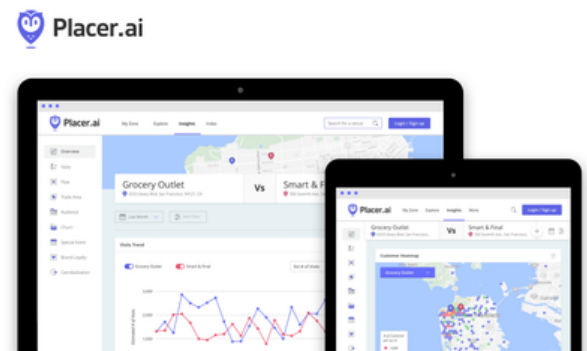
We are proud to welcome five new community leaders to the Chamber Board of Directors:

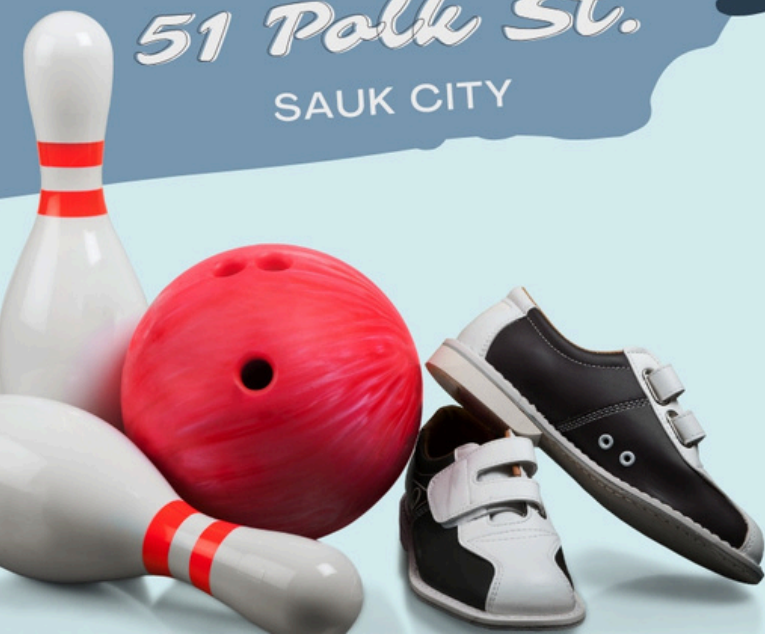
