## *Best Canva Practices for Local Marketing*

### **Start with the Right Size**

Always choose the correct template size for your project—social media posts, flyers, posters, and newsletters all require different dimensions. Starting correctly avoids resizing and quality issues.

### **Keep Branding Consistent**

Use the same colors, fonts, and logo across all designs. Consistency builds recognition and trust within the Sauk Prairie community.

### **Keep It Clean and Easy to Read**

Simple designs perform best. Limit fonts and colors, leave white space, and focus on one clear message per design.

### **Use Quality Images**

Choose clear, high-quality images that reflect your business, nonprofit, or the Sauk Prairie community. Canva's photo library is a great option if you don't have your own images.

### **Customize Templates**

Templates are a starting point—not the final product. Adjust colors, fonts, and layouts to match your organization and avoid a “generic” look.

### **Double-Check Before Sharing**

Always review spelling, dates, times, and locations before posting or printing. For print projects, use PDF Print for the best results.

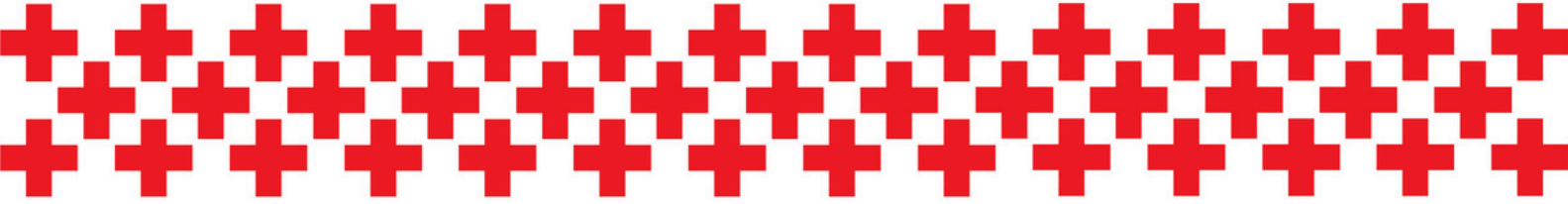
