



Individual Membership Policy

Purpose

Individual membership provides an opportunity for community members to stay connected to the Chamber and support its mission of promoting and enhancing a vibrant business community through leadership, connection, and community.

This membership category is intended for individuals who wish to participate in Chamber activities but who are not representing a business or organization.

Eligibility

Individual Member

Available to individuals not representing a business or professional venture through their membership. Eligible individuals may include government employees, school district employees, elected officials, remote workers not representing their employer locally, and other community members interested in supporting the Chamber.

Employees of businesses eligible for Chamber membership are encouraged to participate through their organization's business membership rather than through an individual membership.

Retiree Member

Available to individuals who are retired and no longer engaged in business, political, or professional ventures but wish to remain connected to the Chamber and the community.

Member Investment (Dues)

Dues for Individual and Retiree members are established through the Chamber's Member Investment Schedule, which is periodically reviewed and approved by the Chamber Board of Directors.

Benefits

Individual members may participate in Chamber programs, events, and educational opportunities at member rates and receive Chamber communications, including newsletters and updates. Individual members may also participate in committees, initiatives, or volunteer opportunities that support the Chamber's work.

Limitations

Individual membership does not include the marketing and promotional benefits provided to Chamber business members.

Individual members:

- Are not listed in the Chamber's online business directory
- Do not receive business referrals from Chamber staff
- May not promote or advertise a business, product, or professional service through their membership

Individual memberships are issued to one person and are not transferable.

Business Representation

Individual membership may not be used to represent or promote a business, organization, or professional service.

Individuals who own, operate, or actively promote a business or professional venture are required to join under the appropriate business membership category.

If an individual member begins representing or promoting a business that would benefit from Chamber marketing or visibility, the Chamber may require the membership to convert to the appropriate business membership category.
