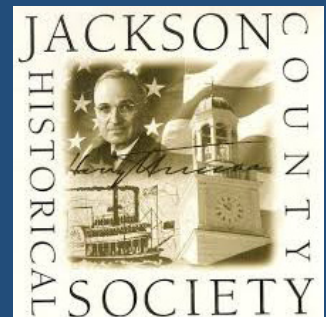

LEAD INDEPENDENCE

In the first quarter of 2019, the Independence LEAD class gained insight into local non-profit organizations, government and economic development in our community. In January, the LEAD class explored the ways non-profits impact and support our community during their visit to BlendWell Cafe, the Boys and Girls Club, Great Plains SPCA, and Truman Habitat for Humanity ReStore. In February, for Government Day, the class heard remarks from Mayor Eileen Weir, and City Manager Zach Walker as well as city department representatives. They traveled to the water treatment plant to learn about how Independence water is processed. In March, Xander Winkel, Director of the Ennovation Center, Jodi Krantz of the Economic Development, and Whitney Watson of Northrop Grumman presented to the group. Finally, the LEAD class visited businesses located underground in the Space Center.
