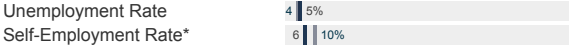

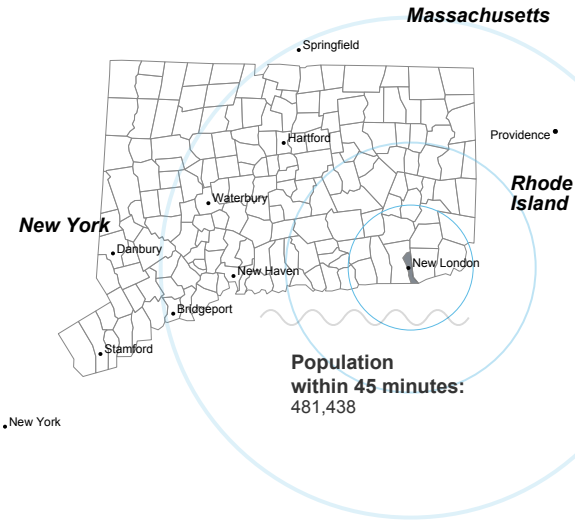
Unemployment Rate
