RESPONSIBILITIES

Members of the NCCBOR Board of Directors help guide the strategic direction, priorities, and long-term success of the association. Board members are expected to:

COMMITMENT

Board service requires an active commitment to leadership and participation within the association.

General expectations include:

- **Attendance** at approximately 6 Board meetings per year, either in person or virtually
- **Reviewing** Board agendas and supporting materials prior to meetings
- **Participating** in discussions and organizational initiatives
- **Supporting** NCCBOR events, programs, and member engagement efforts
- **Maintaining professional conduct and collaboration** while serving in a leadership role

Meeting lengths and time commitments may vary depending on position and organizational initiatives throughout the year.
