Thank you for your interest in serving our association. The Nominating Committee makes final determinations on all candidates. If you have questions about qualifications, please contact us at info@nccbor.com.

In order to run for office and serve, ALL candidates must be members with New Castle County Board of REALTORS® in good standing. Members of the Board are expected to attend a 2-hour meeting every other month and be engaged in other Association activities.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

VICE PRESIDENT

Must be a Primary member of NCCBOR for at least 5 years and must have served as a Board Member or Committee Chairperson for at least 2 years.

TREASURER

Must be a Primary member of NCCBOR for at least 2 years.

DIRECTOR

Must be a Primary member of NCCBOR for at least 2 years.

HOW TO SUBMIT A NOMINATION

- To submit a nomination, visit nccbor.com/2027-nominations to access the form.
- You can nominate **yourself** or someone else.
- If you are nominated by someone else, we will reach out to you to confirm your acceptance of the nomination and request any other information we may need.
- **All nominations are due by 5:00 PM on Sunday, May 31st, 2026.**
- Instructions can be found on the form, and we ask that you be as detailed as possible in your submission.
- The Nomination Committee will meet to review all nominations and select the recommended slate of candidates for each position. Once the Board of Directors approves the slate, selected candidates will be notified.
