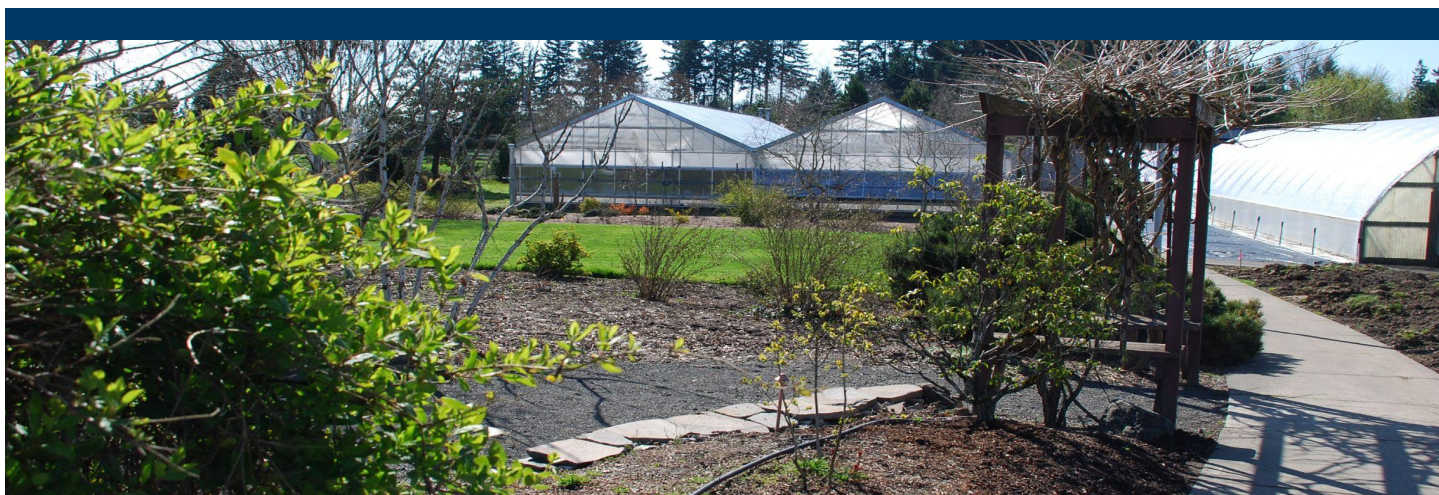




# Landscaping Workshops
