Development in Pearland

The City of Pearland Community Development released their quarterly update for April – June. The report indicated that permits were issued for 13 new commercial projects, 31 for additions, alterations, or accessory, and 12 for tenant finish / build outs. There were also 58 single-family home permits for this quarter. The Pearland Economic Development Corporation recently announced that Syzygy Plasmonics selected Pearland for their new headquarters, R&D and manufacturing facility.

Employment Situation – Pearland has lowest unemployment in region

The September 2022 Houston Area Employment Situation that was released by Workforce Solutions – Gulf Coast shows Pearland still has the lowest unemployment percentage in the region (3.4% down from 3.7% last month). Sales Tax Update

The City of Pearland receives updates on sales tax collection from the state. The report is always from two months prior, so in October, the City receives August numbers. The total net collections increased compared to August by \$340,421 or 10.8%. Pearland in October accounted for 33.4% of the total sales
