### **Development in Pearland**

The Chamber is regularly asked what new developments are coming into Pearland. We recently added the City of Pearland's Active Commercial Permits to the resource section of our website. This link will show active permits across the city including alterations, interior tenant finishes and new construction. Also, our medical community continues to expand in Pearland. Kelsey-Seybold announced the expansion of their clinic on 288 by 27,000 square. Memorial Hermann Pearland Hospital announced an expansion project to add 33 beds on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. Across the region, the Texas Medical Center announced their new 500-acre biomanufacturing center that will bring 100,000 jobs to Houston.

Employment Situation – Pearland has lowest unemployment in region

The August 2022 Houston Area Employment Situation that was released by Workforce Solutions – Gulf Coast shows Pearland still has the lowest unemployment percentage in the region (3.7%). ### Sales Tax Update

The City of Pearland receives updates on sales tax collection from the state. The report is always from two months prior, so in September, the City receives July numbers. The total net collections increased compared to September 2021 by \$319,228 or 10%. ### **Enrollment in Education Institutions in Our Region**

Our two largest school districts began their school year in August. Pearland ISD's enrollment is currently 21,196. The district is the largest employer in Pearland, with approximately 2,736 full-time employees. Alvin ISD's enrollment is currently 29,206. The District's 4th comprehensive high school, Iowa Colony High School, opened to 9th and 10th graders in August 2022. Alvin Community College's enrollment for Fall 2022 is currently 5,198. Dual Enrollment continues to grow for ACC with 2,861 students enrolled at ACC and a local ISD. University of Houston-Clear Lake's enrollment is currently at 8,642. They have 6,415 undergraduates and 2,227 graduate students and the UHCL at Pearland is home to approximately 600 students. San Jacinto College's enrollment across the system is 30,567. The South Campus, located off of Beamer Rd, currently has 12,518 students enrolled.
