Propositions A, B, C and D all passed on the May ballot. Proposition A passed with 65% voter approval. This proposition was related to drainage projects in Pearland. The Chamber started our engagement with City Council in December 2021 and requested them move away from the Stormwater Fee to a comprehensive bond. It took 17 months, but we are excited that the Stormwater Fee was removed and that voters approved the bond. The Texas Legislatures wrapped up their session but will be having a special session to discuss property tax and border security. Two bills that the Chamber supported were HB 5 and HB 8. HB 5 will allow Texas to stay competitive in recruiting and retaining businesses while HB 8 creates a new funding model related to community college performance.

The April 2023 Houston Area Employment Situation that was released by Workforce Solutions – Gulf Coast shows Pearland still one the lowest unemployment percentage in the region (3.6% down from the last month's 4.2%).
