

# YCC Energy Committee

REPORTS TO:	Yukon Chamber of Commerce (YCC) Board of Directors
CHAIR:	John Campbell (December 2023)
MEETINGS:	A minimum of six (6) times per calendar year
COMPOSITION:	The YCC Energy Committee (the “Committee”) is composed of YCC and non-Chamber representatives with knowledge and experience in the energy sector. The Committee is not limited in size but will normally be 8-10 members.
SUBCOMMITTEE:	The Committee may strike subcommittees such as a technical advisory committee in order to provide advice and expertise to the Committee.
MANDATE:	<p>From a business perspective:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify energy (i.e. electricity, hydrocarbon, solar, wind, alternative energy) policy issues, needs, gaps and opportunities;</li><li>• Identify barriers to energy supply;</li><li>• Identify energy security issues and long-term needs;</li><li>• Identify barriers to the development of local, and sustainable energy supply and infrastructure; and</li><li>• Develop briefing notes, letters and position papers to address identified priorities.</li></ul>
FUNCTIONS:	<p>Can include – but not be restricted to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Providing input to YCC submissions to federal government, Yukon government, agencies on key energy related issues;</li><li>• Conducting research on key issues to be shared with YCC Board of Directors, YCC committees, members, and all levels of government;</li><li>• Hosting and participating in business events to discuss energy related issues;</li><li>• Developing resolutions for consideration by member chambers to be presented at the YCC Annual General Meeting and the Canadian Chamber AGM; and</li><li>• Develop an Annual Report for the Committee that will be published in the YCC Annual Report.</li></ul>
STRUCTURE:	To be known as the Yukon Chamber of Commerce Energy Committee, providing input and recommendations to the YCC Board of Directors and staff leadership.
