PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Leadership Laurentian is an original, nine-month leadership experience designed to equip leaders with the character, courage, communication, and confidence to shape the future of Northeastern Minnesota. Through site visits, behind-the-scenes access, and dynamic leadership training grounded in the 7 Pillars of Influence (Character, Courage, Confidence, Communication, Culture, Competence, and Coaching), this program builds the leaders our region needs, now and into the future.

As a member of our inaugural cohort, you won't just participate in the program, you'll help build it. This

first class will play a vital role in shaping the program's future, supporting the next generation of participants, and laying the foundation for a lasting alumni network across the Iron Range.

Participants are expected to be community stewards: curious learners, collaborative thinkers, and committed citizens who care deeply about our region. After graduation, alumni are encouraged to remain involved as program architects and ambassadors, cohort connectors, and advocates for regional leadership.
