Poster Design and Specifications

Each poster presentation will be allotted one panel space of 4' H by 6' W with a folder for any material the presenter wishes to hand out. APPE will have push pins to lend to poster presenters. You should *not* have your poster pre-mounted on arrival.

The title of your submission and all author information (name, institution, etc.) should be included on your poster.

Set Up and Tear Down

It is the presenter's responsibility to put up and take down their poster. Setup is preferred between 9:30 and 1 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 23 so that they can be on display in advance of the Authors Reception & Poster Session, which takes place on Saturday, Feb. 24 from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. All attendees will be encouraged to attend, as they would a concurrent session. Poster presenters will need to be present to engage with attendees.

Teardown is requested between Noon and 3 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 24.
