

REAL ESTATE CORNER

The City of Mobile, Burton Property Group (BPG) and Kessler Capital announced last month plans to develop Mobile's first (and currently only) mixed-use waterfront hospitality and entertainment development. River Walk Plaza will be located on city property on the opposite side of Water Street from the end of Dauphin Street. The new project will sit adjacent to the Mobile Convention Center, bookending the Gulf Quest Maritime Museum and Cooper Riverside Park. The idea was made a reality following the City of Mobile's request for proposals last year for a potential development on the downtown waterfront. BPG is a Mobile-based real estate developer, and Kessler Capital is a Savannah, Georgia-based hospitality developer. Alabama native, architect Gray Reese, President of Gray Reese LLC. Architects, is designing the project. River Walk Plaza is intended to be a destination venue for living, working, dining, and interacting with the waterfront. The site will include high-end condominiums and a luxury hotel; class-A office space; and multiple food, beverage, and retail options. To allow for better logistics, the project will be engineered to provide vehicle and pedestrian access over Water Street and the CSX train tracks. The project is targeting a groundbreaking for early 2025.

Media, Pennsylvania-headquartered convenience chain Wawa broke ground at its first store in Mobile County last month at the intersection of Cottage Hill and Sollie Roads with plans to open by November 2024. Last month's groundbreaking was the second in the region, after one held in June 2023 in Fairhope. Two more additional sites were also announced as under contract. One at the intersection of Schillinger and Old Government Street in West Mobile, and another at Schillinger and Silver Pine roads in Semmes. Wawa invests approximately \$6.5 million in new stores, and each location employs up to 40 employees. Wawa also presented a \$5,000 donation at the event to Feeding the Gulf Coast, reportedly providing 25,000 meals for needy families.

A new Piggly Wiggly grocery store opened last month to fanfare. It is located at 306 S. University Boulevard in West Mobile. The footprint, formerly home to another grocer called Bruno's Supercenter, will house a number of local

partners. These include Flying Pig Coffee Co., Bistro Foods, Three Georges, Namans International Foods, Pigfish Seafood, Lush, Vital Juice, Royal Pharmacy, Cammie's Old Dutch Ice Cream Shoppe and Fresh Sushi.

Pratt Thomas with Merrill P. Thomas Co. Inc. and David Tunstall with McAleer Tunstall Company, LLC represented the sale of a .75 acre of property for \$647,500. The land is located near the intersection of Schillinger Road S and Hitt Road and will soon be home to a Freddy's Frozen Custard and Steakburgers eatery. A grand opening is for later this year.

Cornerstone Caregiving leased some 2,404 square -feet of office space found at 3201 Dauphin Street in Mobile. Leigh Rendfrey of CRE Mobile represented the tenant in the transaction. Chris Harle worked for the landlord on the deal. The company will move its headquarters to the new, larger footprint sometime during the spring of this year from their current site at 2655-B Old Shell Road.

Last month the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers leased 10,240 square-feet of renovated office and warehouse space located at 1242 Montlimar Drive in West Mobile. Chris Harle with White-Spunner Realty represented the landlord in the transaction. Tim Mills of The Cummings Co. worked for the tenant.

A 6,650 square-foot property, found at 2051 Government St, in Mobile was sold last month for \$1.14 million. It was bought by Lyons Capital Group and is currently leased by an Advance Auto Parts retailer. The transaction was handled by Pratt Thomas with Merrill.

Just 4 Us Lounge leased a 3,600 squarefoot building found at 2301 Dauphin Island Parkway in December, and plans to open early this year, according to Pratt Thomas and Pam Helland of Merrill, who handled the deal.

Orlando, Florida-based Tex-Mex chain Tijuana Flats, held a restaurant grand opening in December at 283 McGregor Avenue in West Mobile with events supporting the Dumas Wesley Community Center.
