The MetroWest Chamber of Commerce Arthur 'Ted' T. Welte Scholarship was established to assist public or private high school seniors who actively volunteer in their community at a MetroWest Non-Profit or Charitable Organization and wish to continue their education beyond high school, whether in college, vocational or technical schools. Award will be \$1,000.

Students that meet the following criteria are eligible to submit a scholarship application:

- a. Resident of the MetroWest/495 area of Massachusetts (Ashland, Bellingham Dover, Franklin, Framingham, Holliston, Hopedale, Hopkinton, Hudson, Marlborough, Medfield, Medway, Milford, Millis, Natick, Northborough, Sherborn, Southborough, Sudbury, Wayland, Wellesley, Westborough or Weston)
- b. High School (Public or Private) graduating senior;
- c. Demonstrated financial need (documentation such as a FAFSA will be required);
- d. Provides documentation and verification of working with a MetroWest Non-Profit, Charity, or Community Organization. (i.e., letter signed by organization's Executive Director, Volunteer Coordinator, etc.)

Candidates who are related to any officer or director of the MetroWest Chamber of Commerce, or who are related to any member of the scholarship committee will not be eligible.

Applications may be obtained from your school Guidance Office. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2024.



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Application and Submission Process

A letter of recommendation from your High School Guidance Counselor or Principal.
