




Your area has 67,916 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 69,742.




Retirement risk is about average in your area. The national average for an area this size is 100,726 people 55 or older, while there are 92,883 here.



Racial Diversity


Racial diversity is low in your area. The national average for an area this size is 136,314 racially diverse people, while there are 102,919 here.

Your area has 19.02 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 17.91 per 1,000 people.





Inflow / Outflow: Labor Shed












