
The club further aids the Brandon area through the Community Christmas Tree project. Members erect Christmas trees at local businesses with gift tags for local

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM SIDEWALKS

It shall be the duty of the owner or occupant of any lot or parcel of land in the City abutting on any sidewalk to keep such sidewalk free from snow and ice accumulation. Within forty-eight (48) hours after the termination of any snowfall, the snow accumulation shall be removed. Where, however, it is impossible to keep the sidewalk clear due to frozen conditions, then said owner or occupant shall sprinkle or spread some suitable material on the sidewalk to prevent it from becoming dangerous to travel.

If the owner or person in charge of the lot fails or refuses to remove the snow and/or ice from the sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after written notice has been posted on the property, the City shall have the snow and/or ice removed and charge the costs thereof against the abutting property the sum established by the resolution of City Council.

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING AREAS

It shall be the duty of the property owner, tenant or person in possession of any public or private driveway, parking lot or parking area to dispose of accumulated snow

upon such property in such a manner that any snow when removed shall not be deposited upon any sidewalk, within or upon any public street or alley, or in any manner that will obstruct or interfere with the passage or vision of vehicle or pedestrian traffic.

It shall be the duty of the

property owner, tenant

or person in possession of any property abutting on any sidewalk to dispose of accumulated snow upon such sidewalk in such a manner that any snow when removed shall not be deposited within or upon any public street or alley, after such public street or alley has been cleared of snow by the grading of such snow away from the curb or the picking up and carrying away of such snow by the City. It shall be the duty of any person who removes snow from any public or private driveway, parking lot or parking area, to dispose of accumulated snow upon the property from which it was removed in such a manner that such snow shall not be deposited upon any sidewalk, within or upon any public street or alley. or in a manner that will obstruct or interfere with the passage or vision of vehicle or pedestrian traffic.

DISPOSAL OF SNOW FROM AROUND MAILBOXES

It is the responsibility of the property owner or occupant in possession of any mailbox located upon a driveway, parking lot or public right-of-way to remove and dispose of accumulated snow from the immediate area around the mailbox so as not to obstruct or interfere with the delivery or collection of the United States mail.

DECLARATION OF SNOW REMOVAL ALERT

A snow alert will occur automatically with the accumulation of three (3) inches of snow on the public streets or when the person designated determines that snow removal from the public streets will commence, that person will announce through local news media and whatever other sources are available that there has been declared a snow removal alert and that the provisions of this chapter will be effective and be enforced, designating a particular date and time when such alert shall commence. The determination to declare a snow removal alert will be based on the then existing weather conditions and the amount of snow then on the ground or expected according to forecasts for the national weather

PARKING DURING SNOW REMOVAL ALERT IN ALL AREAS OF THE CITY

Parking on any public street of the City will be completely prohibited, on both sides and regardless of the directional run of that street, during the existence of a snow removal alert.

SNOW REMOVAL - FIRE HYDRANTS

In an emergency, every second matters. Fire hydrants that are blocked, concealed or difficult to access due to snow or ice can impede emergency fire response. Fire trucks carry a finite amount of water, so one of responders' first tasks upon arriving at a fire is to locate a water supply from the nearest hydrant. Hydrants covered in snow can be difficult to locate, and uncovering them can waste valuable time needed during a fire fight. Keeping them clear can mean easier access to water and more time doing what really matters — fighting the fire.

MEDICAL CANNABIS

ORDINANCE NO. 630
A TEMPORARY ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF LOCAL MEDICAL CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENT PERMITS AND/OR LICENSES.

Section 1. Temporary Ordinance - Application for Local Permit/License

A medical cannabis establishment desiring to operate in the Municipality shall be required to apply for a permit and/or license from the Municipality. Applications for a local permit and/or license to operate a medical cannabis establishment, as defined by SDCL 34-20G-1, shall not be accepted until the South Dakota Department of Health has promulgated regulations as required by SDCL 34-20G-72. Any application received prior to such regulations being promulgated shall be denied.

Section 2. Immediate Effect.

This ordinance is necessary to protect and immediately preserve the public health, safety, welfare, peace, and support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions pursuant to SDCL 11-4-3.1 and SDCL 9-19-13.







Word on the Street

Updates on the Rushmore Improvement Project

It's construction season in Brandon! So what's the point of all this road work in our neighborhoods? In this issue of Inside Brandon, we're taking you "inside" the Rushmore Improvement Project. Keep reading to learn what benefits you can expect from the infrastructure development, and how the city is working to mitigate the effects on residents in the area.

A. What is "The Rushmore Improvement Project"?

Short Answer: The City of Brandon is replacing the road in areas where it was rapidly falling apart, and adding storm sewers and sidewalks with access for people with disabilities. They selected DGR Engineering to design the Rushmore Area Reconstruction projects.

Details from the contractor: The streets in the Rushmore area had passed the end of their useful life and the roadway was starting to degrade rapidly in certain areas. Part of the reason for the rapid degradation of the street surface was the lack of storm sewer in the neighborhood. Due to the age of the underground infrastructure, the water and sewer lines will be replaced along with the addition of storm sewer, new curb and gutter and asphalt pavement as well as a four feet wide sidewalk with ADA improvements.

Details from the City of Brandon: A request for proposal (RFP) was advertised in 2019 and a selection committee formed. We had five interested firms. The selection committee recommended DGR and the city council approved. The RFP soliciting a firm described the project at length, but the summary was: "The City intends to engage the services of a consulting firm having specific experience and qualification in each of the areas identified in this RFP. The consulting firm will partner with City staff in all aspects of the project. For consideration, proposals for the project must provide evidence of the firm's experience and abilities in the specified area(s) and other disciplines directly related to the proposed service. Award of contract will be made to the firm offering the best combination of experience, qualifications, price and general project approach."



"The foundation for DGR Engineering was laid in 1952, when a young electrical engineer named John DeWild left his job at Rock Rapids Utilities to pursue his dreams. Soon after, he met with electrical engineer Dick Grant. A simple handshake built a business and partnership that would last for decades. In 1954 Bob Reckert was added to the expanding engineering firm, and together they formed DeWild Grant Reckert and Associates Company, known today as DGR Engineering."

69 years after that single handshake, DGR maintains the same spirit of passion, advancement and partnership on which the company was built. With approximately 150 employees, 58 of whom are shareholders, and three locations in the upper Midwest, DGR looks forward to many more decades of helping businesses, schools and communities grow, and building the foundation for every day.

B. Am I paying for it?

Short Answer: Partially. Your city taxes help pay for infrastructure, AKA sidewalks and streets in your neighborhood. Your utility rates help pay for water and sewer.

Details from the contractor: The first step in the process was to survey the entire project area and develop cost estimates for the work that needed to be done to develop potential phases for the project to meet the financial needs of the City. The City then selected phasing for the project that would work with their budget and had DGR start the design for the first phase of the project.

Details from the City of Brandon: The City funded this project with a Sales Tax Revenue Bond. A Sales Tax Revenue Bond is a loan to the City to be paid back with Sales Tax Revenue. With every dollar you spend in Brandon, two cents goes to the City's General Fund which helps pay for these capital projects. Your city property taxes will not increase due to this project. A portion of this project is water, sewer, storm sewer and street-lights, all of which will be funded with utility rates. The City reviews rates each year to accommodate the capital projects and make sure these funds cash flow.

There is a chance that utility rates will increase to pay for these capital projects. The Total Project budget is 14 million 450 thousand dollars. The breakdown is: Phase 1 = 5.95M Phase 2 = 2.59M Phase 3 = 3.20M Phase 4 = 2.71M Phase 1 construction began Spring 2021. Phase 2 Design will start 2022 with construction planned for 2023. Phase 3-4 have not yet been determined on a timeline.

C. What's happening to my trees?

Short Answer: Your trees might be removed, but the City is replacing them for free-- and you get to choose what kind of tree and where it goes!

Details from the contractors: DGR teamed with Confluence to add landscape and low impact design to the project. Confluence worked through the project impacts to trees that would need to be removed along with impacts to pedestrians and bicyclists and also helped with design elements to a sedimentation basin at the bottom end of the project area. -- DGR Engineering

Details from the City of Brandon: The City of Brandon is happy to partner with Oakridge Nursery & Landscaping to provide a Tree Voucher Program on the Rushmore Area Reconstruction Project - Phase 1. Replacing the removed trees from the neighborhood during this project is a top priority of the city. For every tree removed from the construction area a tree voucher was provided. The Tree Voucher is for one tree purchased and/or planted up to \$400.00 for a tree of their choosing. How many vouchers the resident wants to use is up to them. We plan on using this same system for future street reconstruction projects.

D. What's happening to my mailbox?

Short Answer: You'll have a temporary mailbox during construction, and after the project is done you'll have cluster mailboxes.

Details from the contractor: Temporary mailboxes were set up for the project on Cedar Street north of the post office. When the project is complete cluster box units (CBU's) will be installed in a couple locations eliminating mailboxes at each residence.

Details from the City of Brandon: The Rushmore Project will be replacing existing mailboxes with new Cluster Box Units. CBUs are becoming popular in the Brandon area as many of the existing developments currently have them and all new developments are required to have them. Packages that do not fit in a parcel locker (within the CBU), will be brought to your front door.

E. What should I expect if I live in a future project area?

Short Answer: You'll get a letter from the contractor and the city, and there will be an open house before the construction starts to give you all the details. Phase II is planned to be constructed in 2023 and Phase III construction is planned for 2025.

Details from the contractor: Letters were mailed out to residents prior to the survey taking place and a public open house was held to give residents details of the project and inform them of easements that would be needed. Temporary and some permanent easement documents were prepared and sent to the property owners and DGR conducted many meetings with residents at their homes to discuss easements.


F. What else should I know?

Short Answer: The project also has the environment and worker safety in mind! The designs include a system to separate water from trash, oils and sediment to keep it out of Splitrock Creek. They are also putting in a replacement lift system with a backup generator to keep sewage movement to the water treatment plant safe and efficient.

Details from the contractor: DGR designed new sanitary sewer mains, new water mains and the associated service lines and a storm sewer system to collect stormwater and route the stormwater to the south end of Rushmore Drive to the sedimentation basin. The storm sewer system helps to get the rain water off of the streets and into a sealed collection system to lessen the impact to the roadway surface. The sedimentation basin at the south end of Rushmore Drive has means in place to help collect trash washed off of the streets and to contain sediment and oils from the roadway and allow the City to pick that material up to be disposed of rather than have it carried to Splitrock Creek. The sedimentation basin also slows the discharge of stormwater to Splitrock Creek in smaller rain events but has the ability to be overtopped at the bottom in larger rain events without causing damage to the system. As the City of Brandon grows this helps to meet the upcoming MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) requirements from the EPA that will be placed on the City. The City of Brandon obtained land to provide the area to construct the sedimentation basin. Along with the other infrastructure improvements and the purchase of additional City property there were some improvements needed to the City's lift station that serves the area. The decision was made to relocate and construct a new lift station on the parcel that would contain the sedimentation basin. The new sanitary sewer lift station will replace aging pumps and equipment and keep employees from climbing down into a confined space along with adding an on-site back up generator to provide instant back up in the event of a power outage.

DGR is providing on site construction observation through the project to make sure that the work complies with the design requirements and to work with residents and answer questions and take care of their concerns.

Details from the City of Brandon: New utilities and new streets do cut down on maintenance. Our public works employees do a great job crack sealing and filling pot holes during the summer months. With a new street they can focus on other parts of town that need attention. But even on brand new streets we still want to make sure we keep up with basic maintenance such as spraying weeds in the curb line and sealing those surface cracks with slurry seal. Also, we are replacing the storm drainage infrastructure which helps keep a lot of the water off of the roadway. We are also rerouting some of the stormwater so that it does not directly flow into the Split Rock Creek. Instead, it will flow to the south to a water quality pond. This water quality pond has infrastructure built into it that captures garbage, debris, and oils before it flows to the river. This is one way that we can help protect the quality of our water ways. We also save money with new sewer mains. The old sewer mains crack and separate which allows groundwater to flow into the pipe system which we pipe to Sioux Falls for treatment. We do not have our own sanitary sewer treatment plant so we pay the City of Sioux Falls a fixed amount per 1,000 gallons of water treated by their plant. By replacing the pipe and making sure it is water tight, we are able to cut our flows to the City of Sioux Falls and it saves the City money.


Property tax is one source of revenue that supports the day to day operations of your City. The Minnehaha County Auditor's Office collects all property taxes and then distributes the taxes to the appropriate entity. The City receives about 21.5% of an owner-occupied residential property tax bill. Property tax revenue is a general fund revenue supporting police, fire, streets, snow removal, parks, pool and more. Property tax is one of the major sources of revenue for any City and without this we could not run your City. 
SALES TAX

Sales tax is important to the City and another major source of revenue. This revenue source is not quite as consistent or predictable as property taxes. Sales tax changes with the economy. With every dollar you spend, two cents goes to the City's General Fund. Sales tax revenue is a key component in being able to improve your city. Sales tax pays for debt, projects and equipment in the General Fund.

Paying for Stormwater Management

The City collects utility fees to pay for the operations and improvements of its infrastructure. Similarly, the City will implement a stormwater utility fee that is based on a property's contribution to stormwater runoff. In other words, the fee will be based on total property area and the amount of impervious areas that prevent rainfall or snowmelt from soaking

Why is Managing Stormwater Important?

Stormwater must be managed to protect our drinking water supplies, prevent flooding and preserve natural resources.

State Requirements for Stormwater Management

When the City reaches a population of 10,000 or greater, Brandon will be required to obtain a MS4 (municipal separate storm sewer systems) permit in order to meet federal standards.

Usage of Stormwater Fee Generated Revenue

Revenue generated from the stormwater utility fee will be used to pay for:

- Stormwater utility operation and state/federal permitting requirements.
- Maintenance of current stormwater infrastructure.
- Stormwater infrastructure improvements as recommended in the 2020 Citywide Drainage Planning (see https://cityofbrandon.org/storm).

Paying for Stormwater Management

The City collects utility fees to pay for the operations and improvements of its infrastructure. Similarly, the City will implement a stormwater utility fee that is based on a property's contribution to stormwater runoff. In other words, the fee will be based on total property area and the amount of impervious areas that prevent rainfall or snowmelt from soaking into the ground.

What To Expect

The cost for a residential property will be \$4.91 per month, beginning in January 2022. Fees will increase by 5% per year between 2022 & 2027. Fees may be added to existing utility bills.

Stormwater Frequently Asked QuestionsSummer 2021

What Is Stormwater Runoff?

Stormwater runoff is the water that flows off of roofs, driveways, parking lots, streets, and other hard surfaces during rain events and snowmelt. Any water not absorbed into the soil is also considered runoff. Stormwater and snowmelt that flows into ditches, culverts, and storm sewers does not receive any treatment to remove pollutants before entering our rivers and streams.

> What Is Impervious Area?

Impervious areas are hard surfaces such as structures, asphalt, compacted gravel, concrete, or other man-made surfaces that prevent stormwater from being absorbed by the soil.

> Why Does Brandon Need To Manage Its Stormwater Runoff?

Much like water, sewer, roadways, or solid waste systems, stormwater must be managed to protect our drinking water supplies, prevent flooding and preserve natural resources. Management is essential to protect the quality of the waterways we use for drinking water supplies, recreational activities, and for the health of local wildlife.

Why Is The City Starting A Stormwater Utility Fee?


After completing a stormwater utility feasibility, the City decided to adopt a stormwater utility fee to pay for stormwater infrastructure capital, operation, and maintenance. The primary benefit to instituting a utility fee is it fairly distributes the cost of the City's stormwater services across all eligible properties based on the parcel's contribution to stormwater runoff.

➤ How Is The Fee Calculated?

The City of Brandon will adopt a stormwater utility fee to fund the City's program. A stormwater utility fee is based on total property area and the amount of impervious area on a property that prevents rainfall or snowmelt from soaking into the ground. The cost for a residential property will be \$4.91 per month in 2022. The cost for a pollution generating non-residential property will be \$0.01470 per square foot of impervious area. The cost for a non-pollution generating non-residential property will be \$0.00980 per square foot of impervious area. The rate will increase by 5% annually between 2022 & 2027.

➤ When Will This Go Into Effect?

The utility will be created as a City Ordinance in 2021. The rate will change utility bills starting in January 2022. More information about rates and billing will be available in the Fall of 2021.


