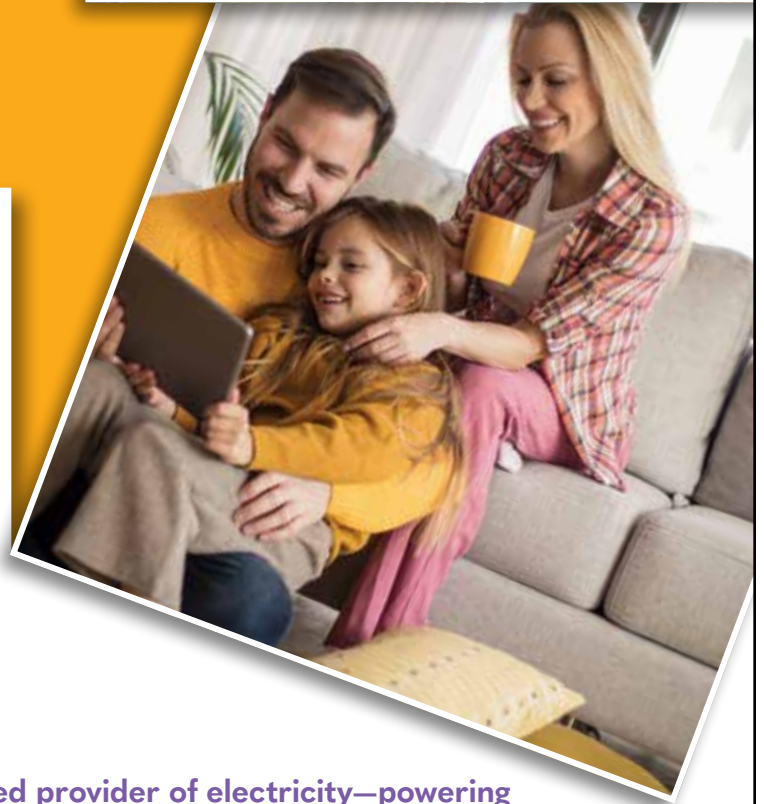
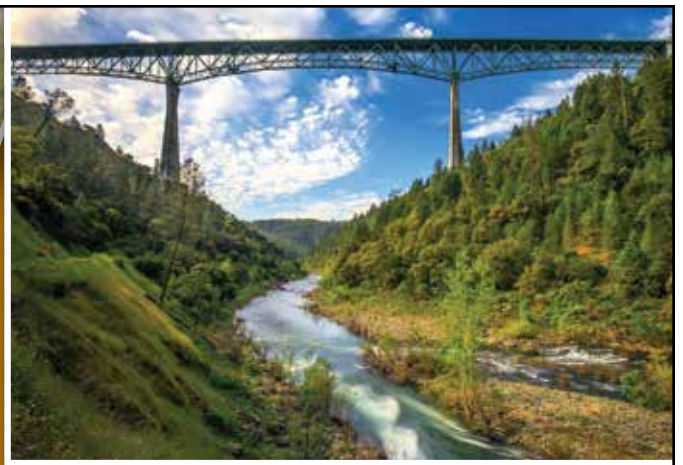

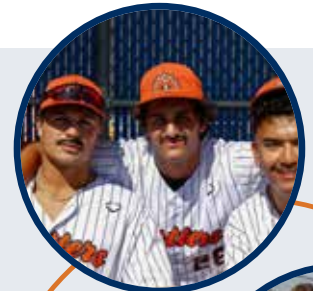

A message from...

LINCOLN AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE PRESIDENT

Greetings from the Lincoln Area Chamber of Commerce. It is that time of year once again to reflect on where we have been and, more importantly, where we are going. During the peak of the global pandemic, the Lincoln chamber has been an essential component of our businesses and our community. Serving our community as a primary chamber tenant has never been more critical than it is today. I'd like to share with you some key issues that we are focusing on and that we believe are important to the future of our community.

As an advocate, our desire is to make Lincoln a better place to live, work and play. On April 14, our chamber hosted a County Supervisor Candidate Night. The purpose of a candidate's night is to give our audience insights into the candidates' thinking and the primary issues that the chamber has on the table so that informed decisions

Homelessness is a difficult problem to solve, affecting cities across our state and is becoming a growing issue in Placer County. During our candidate night, we discussed a number of policies and programs that our leaders are putting forth. The prospect of a homeless campus and other measures in the county were discussed without consensus amongst the candidates. The Lincoln chamber and others in the region are monitoring this issue closely as we have heard from our businesses how this issue continues to adversely affect businesses and that it cannot just be kicked down the road as solutions are needed now.

Traffic on our roadways has exceeded our highway capacity and then some. The county does not have the ability to solely fund the \$3- billion needed to pay for the projects on the table. In order to do so, we will see a future tax measure on the ballot and a matching fund scenario. The impact of traffic congestion will undoubtedly have long-term ramifications for the business community and for the quality of life in Lincoln. As a chamber, we recognize that traffic is an important issue for the future prosperity of our community and quality of life, and we will continue to be a voice for our members and non-members alike.

The American Rescue Plan Act is one of the many programs that were created in response to the COVID pandemic. Placer County received \$77 million, of which the city of Lincoln received \$11 million from the United States Treasury. The chamber has been and is a staunch advocate for business relief for those businesses that were hit the hardest during the pandemic. We are currently working with the city of Lincoln and the business community to ensure that those hit the hardest are able to get the relief that is so desperately needed.

During these unprecedented times, the chamber has forged new relationships and strengthened existing ones. Our membership has grown at a rate that I have not seen in over a decade. This is a testament to the hard work that our staff and volunteer board put in to make Lincoln a desirable place to live and do business. We thank those who have recently joined the chamber as well as our long-standing members. Your support allows us to continue to have a myriad of successes and to be the voice and advocate on behalf of prosperity throughout the region. A message from...

PLACER COUNTY SUPERVISOR

As many of you know, I will be retiring at the end of this year after 28 years of service on the Placer County Board of Supervisors. I think it would be fair to say that retirement for me is bittersweet. I'm excited to adopt a less rigorous schedule but sad to leave this position behind as it has been extremely rewarding. I am honored to have been entrusted with representing the residents of Lincoln for nearly three decades. Through the years, I have done my best to protect the rural heritage of Lincoln while balancing the need for responsible development along the way.

As I contemplate my impending retirement, I find myself thinking more and more about several key accomplishments that were difficult to achieve but have provided a long-lasting, positive impact on Placer County. The Sunset Area Plan is one of those accomplishments that I believe will serve the residents of west Placer by providing a strategic vision to guide planned development into the future ensuring a high quality of life for generations to come.

The Sunset Area Plan was established in 1997 to protect a large area as a site for creating jobs. Placer Ranch, soon to begin construction, includes a 301-acre campus for a California State University, commercial and light

industrial plus various types of residential housing. The county is currently putting in place infrastructure to facilitate this future growth and private interest is growing daily. I anticipate that Buzz Oates, developer of the proposed Placer Commerce Center, will complete his application for development by the end of the year. If approved, the 400-acre business park would bring \$1 billion of investment into the Sunset Area and rival the McClellan Business Park in Sacramento. These projects do not happen by accident but rather through careful planning and relationship-building over a long period of time.

Relationship-building has also been a key component in our partnership with the United Auburn Indian Community. I must take a moment to express my gratitude to the Tribe for their willingness to partner with Placer County through the years to ensure each other's mutual success. Building a casino in the county was controversial to say the least, which is why the board reached out to the Tribe to create a platform where the casino could

be treated like any other business. They agreed. This approach turned out to be the foundation for a successful partnership that continues today. The success of the casino has generated a huge amount of revenue for both the tribe and the county. We are now working together to bring infrastructure to the Sunset Area and the Tribe has agreed to partner in funding the first two miles of Placer Parkway. When fully built out, the parkway will connect state Route 65 in Placer County to state Route 99 in Sutter County, easing traffic congestion on Interstate 80 by providing a secondary route for commuters heading to Sacramento.

And for those who know me well, you know that nearest and dearest to my heart is Placer Legacy, our agricultural and open space preservation plan and the Placer County Conservation Plan. The Placer County Conservation Plan was formally signed by a host of federal and state agencies in 2020, a full 20 years after we initiated the effort. The conservation plan is the one project that kept me from retiring a few years back as I was compelled to see this project to fruition. The conservation plan maps out the way development will occur in west Placer County over the next 50 years and solidifies the vision of Lincoln and the southwest portion of the county. It tremendously amplifies land conservation while streamlining the permitting process for development. Thanks to the Placer County Conservation Plan, future development will occur responsibly and at a reasonable pace for developers as the hard work has already been done to identify conservancy land, mitigation needs and permitting

requirements. I am extremely proud of this accomplishment and am thankful to the many partners who helped complete this monumental effort.

In closing, I feel it's important for me to share how blessed I think we all are to live in Placer County. I honestly believe we live in the finest place in California. We are the gold standard for the entire state with our great quality of life and open space that is protected but accessible to the public. Our county is financially strong and we have nationally recognized programs such as our Placer model of Health and Human Services. This is the foundation we must build on moving into the future and it's important that we look for ways to work together to enhance the value of local government in the county.

I enter into this next season of my life knowing I have made many friends and have been privileged to play a role in some grand accomplishments. I very much look forward to retirement. I want to slow down and catch my breath, spend more time with the grandkids and just do Robert things. Twenty-eight years is a long time in public service. And while I plan to stay engaged in the community, I am looking forward to letting go of the rigorous schedule. My time with Placer County has been a great ride and I am proud to have received your vote of trust in my leadership throughout the years. From the bottom of my heart, I thank you and look forward to serving you through the rest of the year.

LINCOLN PUBLIC LIBRARY BENEFITS ALL AGES

The modern Lincoln Public Library at Twelve Bridges contains more than 40,000 square feet and hosts an impressive collection of books, magazines, DVDs and more. The library, which is celebrating its 15th birthday this year, is a public agency with limited resources and only 10 dedicated staff. As of fall 2021, the facility also serves as the library for the new Twelve Bridges High School.

Friends of the Lincoln Public Library (FOLL) formed more than 35 years ago to support the library. While the library staff actively plans and delivers programming based upon community needs, Friends of the Lincoln Public Library provides about \$50,000 annually plus many volunteer hours to support the library's priorities.

Teens will enjoy the spacious teen center and the Teen Advisory Board helps plan events and book giveaways for our high schoolers.

The whole family can participate in the Summer Reading Program, which offers events and prizes for all ages.

Adults can tune in to an author visit or a book club.

Seniors can access large-print books and a low-vision computer. This is just a sampling of the menu of what the library offers the Lincoln community.

The Lincoln Parks and Recreation staff's Spring/Summer 2022 edition of the Lincoln Recreation Guide is loaded with fun activities for all members of the family.

Those who seek a career in the parks and recreation field are most content when they have an opportunity to create and implement programs for the community they serve. Lately, the smiles have been wide as our staff fills the recreation website and the recreation guide with new programming in four different classifications.

Athletic activities for youth and adults

A youth basketball program just concluded with 24 teams and 265 participants. Staff member Dan Friese provided gymnasium scheduling, locations, coaches, scorekeepers and referees for the entire program.

The Spring Flag Football program involves 300 participants on 26 teams. There are an additional 136 youths signed up for the Youth Volleyball League.

Recreation supervisor Doug Brown is responsible for the Adult Co-ed Softball Program. The spring offering involves more than 200 men and women on 23 teams. The Aquatics program is presently under way at McBean Pool and has a full list of classes for everything from lifeguard training to swim team tryouts. The pool also serves as a great place to treat the kids to an afternoon swim session.

Men's and women's softball is also a very popular program with league activities taking place at the Foskett Regional Park and at Wilson Park. Many teams from throughout Northern California enjoy participating in weekend tournament play at the Foskett Regional Park. The four-diamond complex features adequate parking, convenient restrooms and a snack bar. This is an excellent place to watch some high-quality softball in a comfortable setting.

On a Saturday mid-afternoon, a restaurant door swings open, allowing 12 uniformed players with an insignia from a plumbing company in Modesto to enter with their families for a lunch between games. You can be sure that the cash register will be ringing and the merchant will be smiling, and that's what the hospitality business is all about.

This year, our staff has scheduled almost 40 tournaments. To make it easier for tournament visitors to find businesses in Lincoln, the tournament parks have a large sign displaying their location. The sign was designed and has been maintained for many years by Roger Ueltzen, a former Parks and Recreation Committee chairperson. Tournament softball is big in Lincoln and Roger's contributions to this project have helped to make it so.

Kids camps

Staff member Denise Watson is responsible for arranging kids camps for the winter and spring dates when school classes are not in session. According to Denise, Kids Kamp is the ultimate day camp and has been very popular. There is a lot happening between June 20 and Aug. 12. LINCOLN: A SPECIAL PLACE IN SOUTH PLACER COUNTY

Communities are shaped by their residents and Lincoln draws on both the old and the new as the city's story continues to unfold.

Lincoln is an historic town, with roots first planted in 1859. Fast forward to the first decade of the 21st-century and we were the fastest growing city, adding more than 10,000 people in the United States. Looking at the next 30 years, we are forecast to double from our current population to a community of 100,000-plus people.

But it's the residents who make Lincoln special: those who shaped us in the past (and whose legacy continues to shape us) and the vibrance of our newest neighbors that sets us apart. There are many Lincoln families that go back generations. We're now old enough to see the beginning of our more recent families having their children settle here.

And it's easy to see why Lincoln resonates with people.

More than anything else, Lincoln radiates a sense of "place" where the past is preserved and our future is molded based on distinct communities tied to the city's downtown core. Our General Plan calls for an almost unheard-of 40 percent of all new

developments being reserved for open space. Leave downtown or any of our Villages and within minutes, you're in rural countryside.

Come into town from the south and you will pass Lincoln's Rodeo grounds, home to high school rodeo events for seven neighboring counties.

Head west from downtown to Lincoln Fishery, a catch and release, 20-acre recreation site catering primarily to families.

Just east of downtown is McBean Park and Pavilion, a city facility that includes open space, picnic tables, an indoor shooting range and the baseball stadium – home base for the Lincoln Potters wood-bat college team and William Jessup's baseball team.

Stroll downtown and take in our Art Walk on turn-of-the-century buildings.

The 4th of July parade, the holiday parade, a huge downtown spring Wine Fest, the Chamber of Commerce's fall Showcase (where hundreds of locals enjoy food and beverages from scores of area restaurants and wine and beer businesses), scores of events from local service clubs and organizations... It's all just part of what makes Lincoln a special place to live and work.

WHEELS UP AT LINCOLN'S AIRPORT!

Frank Sinatra once crooned “Come Fly With Me, Let’s Fly Away...” Those words come alive every day as scores of take-offs and landings occur at Lincoln’s airport, the Lincoln Regional Airport.



The airport, owned and operated by the city of Lincoln, is more than just a city asset, it’s a regional drawing card that benefits all of south Placer County.

There are 482 cities in California. Of these, 68 operate airports ranging (based on revenue) in size from \$6,500 (Montague) to Los Angeles International’s \$1.5 billion. Lincoln’s airport checks in with revenues of \$1.5 million, placing it in the mid-tier of the state’s public-use airports.

General aviation (GA) airports, such as Lincoln’s, provide many benefits to the community, from economic activity to safety.

Lincoln’s airport is home to a score of aviation-related businesses, the largest of which – Lincoln Skyways – operates a flight school, a repair and maintenance shop, and an aircraft upholstery facility. There’s also an aircraft painting business, an avionics shop, other flight schools, a helicopter repair facility, and several small businesses catering to general aviation. Our airport is unique in that its businesses can handle virtually any aviation repair activity.

As an economic draw, companies and individuals, “flock” to general aviation airports for convenience and business opportunities. All 238 hangars are filled and there are 50-plus airplanes parked on the tarmac. Discussions are now being held to add additional hangars and to develop an 86-acre parcel of land adjacent to the airport.

In times of emergency, airports provide invaluable assistance in landing supplies or staging supplies for other locations.

The Lincoln Regional Airport has a 6,001-foot runway and can safely handle virtually every general aviation aircraft and most all business jets. The airport has hosted numerous open houses, sponsored by enthusiastic local pilots, and several full-blown airshows attended by thousands of spectators.

The aviation saying, “build a mile of interstate and you only see the next mile; build a mile of runway and you’ll see the world,” is alive and well in Lincoln.

LINCOLN ON TWO WHEELS: LIFE IN THE BIKE LANE

Whether you are a weekend-ride-with-kids bike rider or an avid cyclist, there is a place for you in and around Lincoln.

The weather is conducive to year-round riding with minimal clothing adjustments necessary.

The miles of protected bike paths increase as Lincoln grows, safely connecting neighborhoods for families or the novice rider.

Check out the path around the edge of the Lincoln Crossing area. There are ponds with beaver and it's perfectly flat.

Or take off from Twelve Bridges Middle School on a path that will take you to Twelve Bridge Elementary School or around Coyote Pond Park.

The east end of Moore Road terminates on a short path, taking you by Auburn Ravine Dog Park.

If you are looking for an easy route on the road, generally head west. Moore, Dowd, Nicolaus, Wise, etc., will allow you to ride for miles without a hill.



You can head east on Virginiatown or Fruitvale and encounter only small rollers.

Need a bit more of a challenge? Head north out McCourtney Road toward Camp Far West Lake. There are two or three spots to get your heart rate up just a little but you are rewarded with some spectacular scenes. Turn off on Forbes for some interesting encounters, including longhorn cattle, llamas and a zebra. And a couple of hills.

Hills. You say you want to climb? Head east to Mt. Vernon, Baxter Grade, Chili Hill or Ridge Road – all good names describing what you will encounter. These climbs vary in length from 1.5 to 3.5 miles with grades from 15 to 18 percent in places. Gear down!

Be sure to take some water with you, even on a short ride. If you are going to be out for more than an hour, take something to eat or plan to stop for a donut.

Always wear a helmet and bright clothing. And be sure your kids do, too.

FACILITIES UPDATES FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

The city of Lincoln has seen massive growth with new housing developments and commercial development. With that comes an influx of people and the needs for goods and services increase.

Beyond that, more growth also equals a higher need for educational facilities to accommodate the growing population.

The Western Placer Unified School District partners with the city of Lincoln to maintain a Facilities Master Plan that works in tandem with the city's development plans.

Districts have very limited financial backing when it comes to how they pay for school construction and improvements. Funds come in part from housing developers through fees but those funds are limited. The remainder needed to fund any school improvement or ground up construction is through bond measures, which is money generated through property tax dollars.

In the last five years alone, with the support of our community, we've been able to build two new schools and make major improvements to two existing schools.

In fall 2020, we opened Scott M. Leaman Elementary School, a Lincoln Crossing neighborhood school, to lessen overcrowding from the Lincoln Crossing area's growth.

In fall 2021, the school district welcomed high school students to the highly-anticipated Twelve Bridges High School, a school that was put on hold during the thick of the recession.

The two new schools offer enhanced academic opportunities fit with the latest technology and contemporary designs.

While newly-constructed schools are necessary in some circumstances, finding creative ways to save taxpayer dollars by renovating existing campuses both increases student capacity and enhances educational opportunities for all Western Placer Unified School District students.

With that in mind, Glen Edwards Middle School was originally constructed in the 1950s as an elementary school. The campus did not have the appropriate facilities needed for middle-school academic programs as well as athletic programs.

Broken down into two phases, the Glen Edwards campus received an entire facelift beginning in 2018 after the passage of Measure N, including a new two-story classroom building with a library and a state-of-the-art broadcasting studio.

The second phase of construction included a new gym, music room and renovation of the main entrance, giving it the look and feel of a middle school campus. Existing classrooms were upgraded with new window covers, flooring, paint and cabinetry. In making these improvements, students felt valued and gained a sense of equity while bringing the district's two middle school campuses to the same caliber in terms of facilities and opportunities. Both construction phases were completed by fall 2020.

In 2014, Measure A passed to fund the modernization and expansion of Lincoln High School to accommodate the growing Career Technical Education (CTE) programs and increasing enrollment. Project elements on the main campus included a new classroom building, a modernized front entrance and quad area improvements with covered seating.

Beyond the main campus area, the Lincoln High stadium received new turf and the track was resurfaced.

The entire Lincoln High School addition and modernization project was completed by December 2017 and increased Lincoln High School's student capacity to 2,068.

The completion of these projects, all on time and under budget, would not have been possible without the support of the Lincoln community.

The diligence of the Bond Oversight Committee maintained financial accountability while seeing each project through from start to finish.

Each of the school district's contracting and architecture partners were innovative and brought these campuses into the 21st-century.

While the school district and the city of Lincoln are expecting steady growth over the course of the next several years, continued partnership, proactive planning and community support will maintain adequate educational facilities for the community.



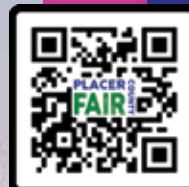
