The non-profit organization of the Year Award recognizes a non-profit for exceptional achievements and contributions to Mountain Communities.

Eligibility

Nominees must:

- Be a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
- Be located in the Mountain Communities and be a member of the Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce with the exception of its officers and directors.

Criteria

The Award Winner will be selected based on their answers to the following questions:

- What are the non-profit organization's core values, goals, and overall mission?
- Please give a brief history of the non-profit organization.
- How has the non-profit organization built and maintained its leadership role in the Mountain Communities?
- What efforts has the non-profit organization made to strengthen other non-profit organizations within the Mountain Communities?
- How has the non-profit organization demonstrated creativity and innovation in meeting the needs of the Mountain Communities?

Nomination Process

Non-profit organizations that meet the award requirements are encouraged to apply directly for the award. In addition a non-profit organization may be nominated by members of the Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce.
