

## **2026 Cary-Grove Area Chamber of Commerce Annual Business Scholarship Application and Instructions**

The Cary-Grove Area Chamber of Commerce will award up to two (2) scholarships of \$2,000. Requirements are listed below. Deadline for submission is Wednesday, April 1, 2026 at 3:30 p.m. Applications received to the Chamber office after this date will not be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applicants must reside within the zip code of 60013 or 60021
Applicants must be in a 2026 graduating class
Applicants must have a minimum overall 3.0 GPA
Applicants must have been enrollment into a two-year or four-year institution of higher learning with intentions or pursuing a business-related career. Some education focuses may include degrees in business, marketing, finance, communications or nonprofit administration. <b>Documentation of enrollment must be included with application.</b>
Applicants must provide two letters of recommendation.
Applications and short-answer questions may be handwritten on this form or typed on a separate sheet of paper.
Applications must be signed by both student and parent or guardian.

Recipients must provide the required institutional details, including the student's college ID, to the Chamber by August 1, 2026. Under no circumstances will payments be made directly to individuals. This program provides a one-time, annual scholarship award.
