
Community Update!

Business Tip:




As we mentioned in our previous business tip, the lending market is tightening up. SBA lending, business loan and lines of credit are becoming tougher and tougher to complete. When this happens, businesses will struggle to grow and will have to maintain status quo. Banks and financial institutions will favor the "perfect" clients over the growing small business clients. A business with minimal debt, great cash flow and high revenue deposits is much more likely to get an easy path to a loan than some small businesses which are aiming for sustainability. This will have a ripple affect with supply chain, not just from a retail standpoint but also as a service provider. We know that costs rise, insurance, equipment, utilities, health care, accounting fees, legal fees, etc. But a big cost increase can be employee costs. A small business that is trying to become sustainable that might not be able to secure a loan to get them over the hump may need to cut back on some sort of expense and when that is employee reduction, they will also lose productivity which reduces revenue and profits. So it is always a catch 22; if you have a strong pipeline, you have billed out work but you aren't collecting your receivables in a timely manner what options will you have against a cash flow shortage? Delaying vendor payments can only go so far, calling and reducing expenses might hold you over for a few weeks but ultimately you may have to sacrifice a big expense such as an employee to keep producing. So, when a company is growing, and they are starting to have cash flow issues because of timing and collection, it is usually a time to seek a business loan or some sort of line of credit to bridge the gap while they wait to receive their funds. This is typically straightforward, however, with the tightening up of lending this might start to create an issue getting those bridge loans and lines of credit. If that happens, businesses will begin to struggle with cash flow, employees will be let go and there will be a market for distressed businesses and unique opportunities for those who are holding cash reserves.

If lending is tightening up and you are looking to secure some additional funds what could be a solution? HELOCs... Home Equity Line of Credits. During the Covid Pandemic many people were able to refinance their homes down to very low interest rates, so the idea of refinancing a home loan to pull cash out with a new loan at a much higher interest rate might not be the best bet. However, many areas did see a spike in home values due to the low inventory and the higher interest rates which gave many people instant equity in their homes.

Many interest rates with HELOCs are tied to the Wall Street Prime Rate which is high now but if you were to lock in a HELOC with an adjustable rate you can take out the money now with your home equity being higher and lock in a term for 20-30 years with the interest decreasing over time. So instead of locking yourself into a refinance at a higher rate to get the cash out of your equity, you can turn to a HELOC which you can use the funds for short term bridges and pay it back just like a business line of credit.
