## About

The goal of the Highland Wildlife Management Area is to maintain and enhance habitats that support game and non-game wildlife while providing opportunities to hunt, fish, trap and view wildlife.

The Highland Wildlife Management Area's three separate tracts of land - Jack Mountain,
Bullpasture Mountain, and Little Doe Hill,
comprise a total of 14,283 acres.

Timber types are primarily upland, hardwood forests of oak, hickory, and mixed oak stands. A major exception to the almost continuous forest habitat is an 80-acre section of blue grass sod on the Jack Mountain tract. Some small wildlife clearings and seeded logging roads provide other open spaces.

Highland County, home to the Highland Wildlife
Management Area, has the highest average elevation of any county east of the Mississippi, and the topography varies from gently sloping to steep with elevations range from


1.800 ft to 4,390 ft.
