VACCINATION UPDATE

The vaccine is now more widely available and there is no shortage. Ohioans can visit <u>gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov</u> to look for open appointments or call 833-4-ASK-ODH to book an appointment over the phone.

More than 4.4 million Ohioans—or 38%-- have received their first vaccine shot.

Businesses: Businesses who want to partner with vaccine providers to vaccinate their employees at work should visit coronavirus.ohio.gov.

High Schools, Colleges and Universities: The state is working with high schools, colleges and universities to offer vaccination clinics for students who are 16 or older.

Johnson & Johnson Vaccine: Vaccine providers are permitted to resume Johnson & Johnson vaccinations in Ohio.

COVID-19 SAFETY UPDATE

COVID-19 Variant: The virus variants are more contagious among those who have not been vaccinated. Visit <u>coronavirus.ohio.gov</u> for a FAQ page about variants.

COVID-19 Spread: Cases, while high, seem to have plateaued. A majority of Ohio's counties are still experiencing a high occurrence of COVID-19 spread within communities (<u>see this week's data</u>).

Updated Health Orders: Ohio Department of Health has updated two health orders:

- Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-Congregating, and
- Visitation at Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facility Residents.

TALKING POINTS FOR YOU

- The Johnson & Johnson vaccine was paused to allow a thorough review of the facts and time to educate healthcare providers on the rare events. Now, a comprehensive analysis by the independent medical professionals on the ACIP has resulted in the recommendation that the benefits of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine outweigh the risks, and that vaccine administrations resume.
- We are seeing more cases of the COVID-19 variant, and it's being closely monitored by health experts. We can offset this as long as we don't faulter. We must consistently wear our masks and get vaccinated as soon as we can.
